The polls will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. These sites are accessible to elderly voters and voters with disabilities.

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. Any voter may declare upon oath that the voter is blind, has an inability to read or write, or is, by any reason of physical disability *other than intoxication*, unable to cast a vote without assistance. The voter may request assistance from a precinct election official or anyone in the polling place except the voter's employer, employer's agent, or an officer or agent of the voter's union. At this Primary Election, candidates are to be nominated by the Republican, Democratic and Libertarian parties for the following offices: United States Representative: District 2, Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of State, Treasurer of State, Secretary of Agriculture, Attorney General, State Senator: District 41, State Representative: District 82, State Representative: District 84, 1 Board of Supervisors, County Treasurer, County Recorder and County Attorney.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Pre-registered voters who are unable to show an approved ID may sign an oath of identification for an election held in 2018. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts also may be required to provide proof of residence. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another registered voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification. In accordance with the provisions of Section 52.35 of the Iowa Code, the Jefferson County Auditor/Commissioner of Elections will conduct a public test of electronic voting equipment for the June 5th Primary Election.
