

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’  
PROCEEDINGS  
October 5, 2009**

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Burgmeier called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Jefferson County has been petitioned by the adjacent property owners to vacate Ironwood Ave. located in Sections 28 & 29 of T72N, R10W, Center Township from the BNSF Railroad north to 200<sup>th</sup> St.

AND WHEREAS, said part of present right-of-way is no longer necessary for or required for use by the public for highway purposes and will not hereafter be required for construction or maintenance purposes of any highway;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by Jefferson County that said part of present right-of-way herein described, together with any and all rights of Jefferson County in and to the same are hereby abandoned, and Jefferson County hereby disclaims any right, title or interest in and to said part of present right-of-way or to the use thereof for any purposes whatsoever.
