

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS'**  
**PROCEEDINGS**  
**May 1, 2017**

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Reed called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Richard C. Reed, Chairman; Dee Sandquist, Vice-Chair; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the minutes for the April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Sandquist to have a summer work experience program for youth. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed the Secondary Road Department requested purchase of a pick-up truck.

It was moved by Sandquist to transfer County vehicles to the Board of Supervisors instead of trading in. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed fireworks regulations.

At 9:30 A.M., Dimmitt moved that the public hearing regarding the Ordinance Amending Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (2010), Adding Chapter 6-50 Establishing a Policy for the Construction and Reconstruction of Roadways and Bridges on the Jefferson County Secondary Road System be opened. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Chair Reed called for public comments. Public comments received were as follows: None.

Dimmitt made a motion to close the public hearing. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Dimmitt to approve the Ordinance Amending Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (2010), Adding Chapter 6-50 Establishing a Policy for the Construction and Reconstruction of Roadways and Bridges on the Jefferson County Secondary Road System. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt to waive additional readings of the ordinance from first to the third. All "Aye". Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt for Dee Sandquist to work with Pat McAvan and Van Buren County on a Memorandum of Understanding for Mental Health staffing. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Sandquist left to attend another meeting.

Supervisors met with the County Engineer.

Supervisors discussed the sale of the County cropland.

Reed reported on his FEDA meetings. Dimmitt reported on his RUSS, Area 15 Regional Planning and 10-15 Transit meetings.

Public Comment: There was a potential nuisance ordinance violation reported of an auto repair shop near Pleasant Plain dumping tires.

It was moved by Dimmitt to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Supervisors toured County roads.

There being no further business the board adjourned.
