

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’
PROCEEDINGS
March 12, 2018**

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Richard C. Reed, Supervisor.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the minutes for the February 26, 2018 meeting be acknowledged. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

Supervisors discussed options for improving, gating or closing dirt portions of 223rd St, Hackberry Way, and 220th St., between Hemlock Avenue and Libertyville Road.

It was moved by Reed to approve the County Road Department’s acquisition of a mulcher attachment for the excavator. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt to approve the County Road Department’s acquisition of a rotary cutter, tractor-pulled batwing mower for \$23,730. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the disposal system contractor’s license for Kremer Well Drilling & Custom Dozing Inc. be reinstated. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed nuisance properties.

Reed reported on the fire alarm system and the Courthouse sidewalks to the handicap entrance. Dimmitt reported on his RUSS Board meeting.

Public comments: None.

It was moved by Reed to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board toured County roads.

At 1:30 P.M., Supervisors held a work session on the County nuisance ordinance.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
