

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’
PROCEEDINGS
May 29, 2018**

At 9:01 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Richard C. Reed, Supervisor.

It was moved by Reed that the minutes for the May 21st, 2018 meeting be acknowledged. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

The Board discussed the use of French Reneker Associates on Dakota Access Inspection.

It was moved by Reed that the Extension Agreement by and among City of Fairfield, County of Jefferson and Fairfield Community School District for the extension of the division of revenue under Iowa Code Section 403.19 in the Lincoln Avenue Urban Renewal Area for the City of Fairfield, Iowa, for projects involving the provision of public improvements related to housing and residential development for a total of fifteen (15) fiscal years of division of revenue (beginning with the second fiscal year after the year of first certification of debt) in connection with the housing projects be approved. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Reed that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors approve the Liquor License for Four Corners Restaurant. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

Supervisors discussed the Nuisance Ordinance Policy and Procedures.

Reed reported on the Maasdam Barns and the Courthouse sidewalks. Sandquist reported on her Early Childhood and Daycare meetings. Sandquist also reported on that she’d worked on the County safety policies. Dimmitt reported on his 10-15 Transit, Area 15 Regional Planning, RUSS and SEIDA meetings.

Public comments: None.

It was moved by Reed to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Dimmitt and Sandquist toured County roads.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
