At 9:00 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

**BE IT RESOLVED:** to adopt Bridge Inspections and Posted Ratings as proposed by Calhoun Burns and Associates yearly 2018 Bridge Report to use as the legal weight and load limits for structures in Jefferson County. As shown in Exhibits “A “& “B” for the Changes.
