

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’
PROCEEDINGS
November 19, 2018**

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Richard C. Reed, Supervisor.

It was moved by Reed that the minutes for the November 13, 2018 meeting be acknowledged. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Reed that the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County approve the pay increase of Melissa Fowler, County Auditor’s Accounting Clerk, to \$1,575.24 per pay period effective November 16, 2018. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Reed to set the public hearing on the new in-car video system lease to buy program for the Sheriff’s Office for December 10, 2018 at 9:45 A.M. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

It was moved by Dimmitt to set a public hearing for FY 19 budget amendment on December 10, 2018 at 9:30 a.m. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

Sandquist reported on her SEIL and Economic Development meeting in Ottumwa. Dimmitt reported on his 10-15 Transit, RUSS and Area 15 meetings.

It was moved by Reed to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All “Aye”. Motion carried.
